After morning snack, sunscreen was applied, and water bottles were brought as the groups transitioned to the outdoor play area. The 2-year-old class were the first group to arrive outside. They were observed enjoying a popsicle before the other group joined them on the playground. The Educators were heard calling the children for water breaks several times while playing outside. Some children were observed playing in the large sandbox area, using shovels and trucks while others were seen running, using the climber and jumping off wooden

The transition back inside the facility was smooth. The Educators encouraged the children to choose a color on the walking rope to hold onto as they crossed the parking lot. Once inside, the children asked to have a dance party with music and a disco ball. One Educator stayed in the room dancing and singing with the children while the other Educator was observed changing diapers and washing hands for lunch.

stumps. The Educators were well spread out on the playground to ensure proper supervision of all areas.

The facility is clean, organized and bright. They had extra staff on site to help with transition periods, heating lunches and extra cleaning. Child profiles were reviewed during today's Monitoring Inspection. The files were easily accessible and contained all required documents. Only positive child guidance was observed. Throughout the morning, the Educators were observed modelling and positive redirection with the children. "Lets climb over here on the climber. We can jump off the wooden stumps! Can you show me how high you can jump?" A conversation was had with the Operator about adding larger holes in the tires in the outdoor play area to ensure proper drainage of water
