General Comments					
A Monitoring Inspection occurred July 2, 2025.					
Children were observed during indoor free play. Educators shared that the children are currently very interested in going on walks to local attractions, visiting the splash pad, building with LEGO, making Perler bead art, being active outdoors, and engaging in imaginary play, such as creating forts indoors. Positive child guidance techniques were observed throughout the facility. Educators were seen responding to children in a supportive and respectful manner. Parents are kept informed of any incidents that occur, and incident report forms are completed for all reportable incidents. Monthly emergency evacuations are conducted and posted as required. The facility has a clearly visible and prominent space where the license, current inspection report, monitoring reports, and any orders for compliance are posted. The daily routine and evacuation procedures are also clearly posted in accessible and visible locations.					
Books available in the environment have been selected to reflect the children's current interests. The facility is equipped with a varied and age-appropriate supply of materials, books, toys, and equipment. There are several well-defined learning centers, including spaces dedicated to building, reading, dramatic play, and music exploration.					
Traffic areas inside the facility are clean and organized, and outdoor walkways are kept clear and free of clutter. Toxic products such as cleaning supplies are locked away and inaccessible to children. Drinking water is readily available and provided throughout the day. Various forms of literacy are present and integrated throughout the indoor environment, supporting children's language and communication.
