Comments: The Quality Assurance Monitor observed in one classroom that 4 out of 13 lunch boxes were not labelled with the child's name. Food brought from home must be labeled with the child's name.

The Quality Assurance Monitor is on site to conduct the renewal inspection. The ratio was respected during the inspection. The QAM had a discussion with the administrator regarding ibuprofen (Advil) consent in the child's file. A facility can only provide acetaminophen (Tylenol) with the parents' consent. Ibuprofen can only be provided by the parents with a signed consent form. The administrator must create another consent form with only acetaminophen to be provided with the consent of the parents. The new form must be signed by the parents and inserted in the children's file. This will be verified during the next monitoring inspection. The QAM also observed in certain children's profiles that CPS was inserted for the emergency contact information. For emergency contacts, CPS is no longer accepted. The QAM observed a group of children having no school for the day. The children were observed playing in the outdoor play area and then transitioning to lunchtime. The other children were observed arriving to the center after school.
