The administrator informs the Quality Assurance Monitor that she contacted the parents to request the information of two emergency contacts, but the parents were not able to give that information. The operator must do the necessary follow-ups to ensure that the emergency contact information be added in the children's profile. Deficiency is now compliant.
