## **General Comments**

Name of operator

On July 29, 2024, a Monitoring Inspection took place. Children were observed during indoor free play.

Educators mentioned that the children are currently very interested in building structures with Lego, being active outdoors, and playing board games in small groups. Positive child guidance techniques were observed throughout the facility. Educators were at the children's level, providing appropriate supervision, using positive language, offering choices, and assisting children in decision-making. Outdoors, educators played an active role in children's activities.

Outdoor play occurs for at least one hour in each four-hour block of time when the majority of children receiving services are in attendance, weather permitting. Monthly emergency evacuations are completed and posted. The facility has a clearly visible and prominent place to post the license, current inspection report, current monitoring reports, and orders for compliance. Snacks are provided at least every three hours, and meals are served at recognized meal periods. The daily routine is posted in each room. Parents and children are greeted with enthusiasm upon arrival. Books have been selected that reflect the children's interests. The facility had a varied supply of appropriate equipment, materials, books, and toys. Well-defined learning and play areas were observed, with a selection of pieces of the children's artwork displayed throughout the facility. Traffic areas are kept clean, and outdoor walkways are free of clutter. Toxic products, such as chemical cleaners, are locked and inaccessible to the children. Drinking water is provided throughout the day. Outdoor stationary equipment is
