General Comments

A Monitoring Inspection occurred on November 26, 2024.

During the inspection, children were observed engaging in both indoor and outdoor free play as well as snack time. Proper handwashing procedures were followed as children transitioned to snack time, with steps or platforms provided to ensure that all children could comfortably reach the sinks.

Educators shared that the children are currently very interested in being active outdoors, making Christmas ornaments from loose parts, and playing board games in small groups. During the observation, educators were seen using positive language and offering gentle reminders to guide the children's behavior in a supportive and respectful manner.

The facility was found to be well-maintained and compliant with regulations. A daily incident log is kept, and parents are notified of incidents as required, with incident report forms completed for any reportable events. Parents are also permitted entry to the center at any time. Each group of children is provided with outdoor playtime, and monthly emergency evacuations are conducted and posted. The facility ensures that important documents, including the license, current inspection and monitoring reports, and orders for compliance, are displayed in a clearly visible and prominent area. A daily routine is posted in each room, and life-threatening allergies are also posted for reference.

The environment within the facility is inviting. The materials and resources are arranged to encourage active play, and books are thoughtfully selected to reflect the children's current interests. Well-defined learning and play areas were observed, and several pieces of children's artwork were displayed throughout the space. Traffic areas were kept clean, and outdoor walkways were free from clutter. Toxic products, including chemical cleaners, are securely locked and inaccessible to children.

Food brought from home is clearly labeled with the child's name, and drinking water is made available to children throughout the day. The outdoor stationary play equipment is surrounded by protective surfacing with an appropriate depth to ensure safety.

General Comments

The curriculum at the facility is thoughtfully planned, with daily activities that allow opportunities for both individual and group experiences, and various forms of literacy are incorporated into the indoor environment .
