General Comments					
A Monitoring Inspection occurred March 5, 2025.					
Children were observed engaging in indoor free play and transitioning Ifrom lunch. Proper handwashing procedures were followed during the transition. Educators noted that the children are currently interested in a variety of activities, including building snowmen outdoors, creating paper-mâché bowls and characters, constructing with Legos and blocks, and playing in an imaginary restaurant.  Educators were actively engaged with the children, using positive language and providing gentle reminders. They played an active role in supporting and facilitating children's activities. A daily incident log is maintained, and parents are informed of incidents as necessary. In cases of reportable incidents, incident report forms are completed. Monthly emergency evacuations are conducted and posted for reference. Evacuation procedures are clearly displayed in a prominent location. Life-threatening allergies are also posted for awareness.					
The facility maintains a well-organized and engaging learning environment. Books have been carefully selected to reflect children's interests. Clearly defined learning and play areas were observed, and children's artwork was displayed throughout the space, fostering a sense of belonging. Opportunities for both individual and group experiences were available, and various forms of literacy were present in the indoor environment. Drinking water is accessible to children throughout the day.					
Outdoor stationary equipment is surrounded by protective surfacing of appropriate depth, ensuring a safe play environment. The facility's license, current inspection report, monitoring reports, and any orders for compliance are displayed in a clearly visible and prominent location. The daily routine is also posted for reference.
