Blue Group – Indoor Learning

The Blue group was participating in a multicultural learning activity focused on exploring countries around the world. The educator and children were highly engaged, demonstrating meaningful interaction and sustained interest.

The indoor environment was well-resourced, offering a variety of materials to support learning, including art supplies, dramatic play materials, literacy resources, and LEGO.
