General Comments

Discussed with operator current documentation. Ensure that some current documentation is displayed for the children and educators to revisit throughout the day. Some documentation should be kept in the child's portfolio and some can be sent home with children as the parents are currently not able to enter the building and view displayed work.

Nap mats to be removed that are less then 5cm thick. Operator states these are not currently being used for children as they are at the bottom of the pile.

Positive interactions were observed between children and educators during play, snack, story time and washroom routines.

Ensure materials/ toys are rotated during cleaning to be sure that there are toys and materials accessible to the children when they come back inside from outdoor play.

Floor in twos room buckling. Operator states that it was saturated during sanitizing of materials and that they are working towards a solution to fix the floor. Will follow up during follow up inspection.

Update allergy information as the posting is for a child who no longer attends the facility.
