Different forms of documentation were throughout the physical space that represent children's home and community environments.

Purposefully designed indoor and outdoor spaces allowed independence for each child to access materials independently that peaked each of their interest and curiosities. Areas were flexible and offered opportunities for vigorous play and risk taking.

Licensing had a conversation with admin to de clutter shelfing to present a more tranquil environment for the children.

All staff files were observed and complete. Childrens files were observed, and two emergency contact phone numbers are missing and need to be added.
