<p>General Comments</p> <p>Renewal Inspection:</p> <p>During the inspection, the infants and preschool children were observed participating in a variety of activities, including block play, musical chairs, monster hunt, puzzles, coloring, and dizzy play. The educators were actively engaged with the children by joining in their play, listening and responding to children's requests, singing songs, and providing transition activities to support smooth transitions throughout the day.</p> <p>Outdoors, the infant children were observed playing with balls, using the slide, engaging in pretend play by using tools to "fix" cars and play equipment, and driving Little Tikes vehicles. The preschool classrooms were observed participating in walks throughout the neighborhood.</p> <p>The program documentation was current and posted throughout the facility. The educators shared that the infants are currently interested in animals, exploration, and schema play. The preschool educators reported that children are currently interested in nature, exploration, group games, and puzzles.</p> <p>The transitions in all rooms were observed to be smooth and well managed. All classrooms were observed going outside, handwashing routines, mealtimes, and nap time. The educators were consistently observed engaging in positive interactions with the children. The classroom environments were calm, organized, and inviting. Materials were age appropriate, accessible at the children's level, and available for exploration throughout the day.</p> <p>The following records were reviewed: Incident logs, fire drills, educator professional learning hours, infant toddler daily sheets, and daily attendance sheets.</p> <p>All the staff files were viewed, and a random review of the children's files was completed.</p> <p>The inspector discussed professional learning (PL) hours with the on-site administrator. Five educators currently require additional hours to meet the 10-hour annual requirement. The administrator is aware of this requirement</p>

and confirmed that all educators will have the required hours completed by May 30, 2026. QAM will follow up on this item during the next Monitoring Inspection.
