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| <p>General Comments</p> <p>Monitoring Inspection:</p> <p>A monitoring inspection was conducted in the afternoon for both the infant and preschool groups.</p> <p>The infants were observed waking from their nap and transitioning to snack time. The educator was seated with the infants throughout the snack, engaging them in conversation. The educator asked questions and verbally labeled the foods being served, supporting language development and encouraging early communication skills.</p> <p>The preschool children were observed participating in a variety of activities, including snack, water play, bingo, gross motor play, coloring, and block construction. The educators were actively engaged with the children, sitting alongside them, facilitating conversations, and providing support as needed to enhance learning and play experiences.</p> <p>All rooms were observed preparing for outdoor play, with educators supporting children in dressing appropriately and following established routines to ensure a smooth transition outdoors.</p> <p>Purposeful planning was evident through documentation displayed throughout the learning environment. The documentation included clear connections to the New Brunswick Curriculum Framework. Appropriate handwashing routines were observed during washroom use and prior to snack times.</p> <p>Monthly fire drills are documented and up to date. Daily attendance records were reviewed and found to be accurate, reflecting all children in attendance. Child-to-staff ratios were observed to be in compliance during the monitoring inspection. All required documentation is appropriately posted on the parent board.</p> |
