Comments: One staff didn't have a signed statement regarding obligations under the Act and licensing regulations. A signed declaration must be placed into each staff member's file.

Comments: Bottles of Febreze and Lysol wipes were found in a place accessible to children. Toxic products, chemical products and cleaning supplies must be locked and inaccessible to children.

Comments: Facility has a separate locked storage space for medication, but the key was in the lock. Medications must be locked and inaccessible to children. Administrator immediately put the key away. Deficiency is now compliant			

General Comments

Monitoring inspection conducted.

During the visit, QA monitor verified storage spaces. Administrator was informed of the importance of storing toxic products, cleaning products and medications in a locked storage space.

She also entered a new staff member's information into the system. Programming book was verified. The facility has a good variety of purposely planned activities. Other than playing sports with the children, QA monitor was able to see that other opportunities were available. Opportunities such as ways to explore various

forms of literacy, ways to express creativity and interests, arts, sciences and much more.

QA monitor and administrator had a discussion regarding article 10(6) of the Act and licensing regulations. The number of children grouped at a full-time early learning and childcare center shall not be more than the number that requires 2 educators. The operator needs to have a plan to divide the group into several groups when the number requires more than 2 educators. During the next inspection, QA monitor or inspector will verify if a plan is in place when numbers require more than 2 educators.
