General Comments

This was the first monitoring visit to the center after changes had been made to the program. I wanted to observe how the program was running, as well as observe how the rooms were set up. The program added a new room with a full day program for the four year old group while maintaining the morning and afternoon preschool programs in the original room.

I first observed the preschool program. The children were participating in free play. The room is set up very well into centers. There are lots of materials for the children to play with on low accessible shelves. I saw some children's paintings drying on the drying racks, and there were art supplies out on the table for children if they wanted to create something. The children appeared to be having fun playing with the various materials. After playing for a while the children started to clean up and get ready for pick up.

I also observed the four year old room (senior preschool) program. The room seems to be set up well. There are various centers and lots of materials for the children to play with. The materials are stored low and are accessible to the children. They went outside to play, and upon coming in they read a book and then had some lunch. Some children from the preschool program join this room in the afternoon.

The washrooms appear to be clean and tidy. There were paint cans under the sink that need to be locked up. They had a person painting some things this morning and that is why they are out. Paint is now stored elsewhere.

I observed lots of positive guidance by the educators. They demonstrated techniques such as gentle reminders, encouragement, redirection. They also showed caring, kindness and patience with the children.

The program appeared to be running well during my visit.
