A conversation was had regarding outdated photos. A conversation was had with operator regarding art supplies. Art supplies are to be accessible and plentiful. During today's Monitoring Inspection, children were observed sitting at the table, mark marking, gluing, and cutting. Children appeared to be very interested in arts & crafts. The outside environment was not observed today.
