### General Comments

A Monitoring Inspection occurred July 7th, 2025.

The children were observed engaging in a variety of activities, including napping, snack time, and free play. Handwashing occurred before the transition to snack.

Educators indicated that the children currently show interest in playing with large bouncy balls, exploring books, observing worms, going on walks, and engaging in sensory and exploratory play such as pouring, dumping, and filling containers.

Several forms of documentation were visible in the indoor environment. These included individual child portfolios, learning stories, photographs, and children's artwork, all of which reflect ongoing learning.

A clearly visible and prominent area is designated for posting the facility's license, current monitoring reports,

and any orders for compliance. Additional documentation observed included incident logs, daily attendance records, and records of evacuation and monthly fire drills.

The diaper changing area is located within one meter of a sink, supporting proper hygiene practices. Diaper changing procedures were posted and clearly visible. Diaper changing procedures were observed and followed appropriately.
