Comments: Half of the audited files have incomplete address information for the emergency contacts. All files must be updated with complete contact information for 2 emergency contacts.

Comments: There is no soap available in the washrooms. Soap must be replenished before it is empty. Recommend that spare bottles be stored onsite.

Comments: Protective receptacle covers missing and there are preschool children present. Children ate snack on mats on the floor, however the area was not sanitized prior to eating and was not cleaned after. Crumbs were left behind on the mats.

Comments: Wooden logs/stumps around the sandbox and on sliding hill are cracked and splintering, the sharp edges pose a hazard. Staff made a note on the playground checklist that they notified the Operator of this deficiency on June 27, intend to have repaired Aug 24-25. Hole in side of sliding hill must be filled in. A hole going under the fence, beside the sliding hill, must also be filled in. Plastic casing around door is cracked and sharp edges present as well as a sharp piece is sticking out. Must be removed.
