General Comments

As noted on Sept 26 and not yet corrected: small room that was recently converted back into play space has two large shelves, covered in sheets, and a filing cabinet lining one wall. These storage units are taking away from the measured play space. Only moveable shelving units used for children's play equipment and materials are not deducted from measured playspace, therefore the filing cabinet and shelves must be removed from the playspace.

The above mentioned wall of shelves are overloaded, heavy and do not seem sturdy. Sheets cover the shelves and could be pulled on, causing them to fall over onto children. These shelves must be removed from the playspace.

Two bottles of rubbing alcohol were on one of the above mentioned shelves. Toxic products must be kept in a locked cupboard. This was corrected during the inspection.

Staff were engaged with the children, playing games and supervising to ensure safety of children.
