 Comments: As stated under section "10.7.3 Fire Safety" page 86 of the Operator's manual in the "What you Need to Know" portion of 10.7 Fire Safety; "Operators practice the following general fire safety precautions: protect children from access to fireplaces, free standing stoves (woodstoves), furnaces and hot water Heaters". The hot water heater and electrical panels for this center are located in an unlocked closet in one of the washrooms. As the children are school-age and use the washroom unsupervised, QAM asks the center to lock this closet in order to ensure children have no access to the hot water heater.

QAM Monitor observed these items during the monitoring inspection :

Quality Assurance Monitor notes that the center has a system of children's name tags that they have created to move between spaces to ensure rooms are not over capacity. Quality Assurance Monitor observed children engaged in a variety of indoor activities including Valentine's Day crafts, hockey, lego, balance beam activity, and floor scooters. Children then cleaned up and prepared for outdoor play. Quality Assurance Monitor observed an instance of child falling and an educator providing comfort, positive guidance, and an ice pack. In another instance two children were struggling to handle a behavior and the educator spent time discussing the situation with the children and resolving the issue in a positive way.
