<p>General Comments</p> <p>The following elements were verified at the time of the monitoring inspection:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -The child-educator ratio. -Posted at the entrance: the daily routine, fire evacuation instructions, the name of the administrator, the names and phone numbers of the quality-assurance mentor and the inspector, and any reported illness when required. The inspector's and quality-assurance mentor's cards were provided to be visibly displayed at the entrance of the facility. -The children's daily attendance records are available on site. -The indoor play area is safe and clean. -The indoor materials are varied and available in sufficient quantity for all children present. There is a large room where the after-school group has access to about a dozen basketballs, volleyballs, soccer balls, bowling pins, and hoops. There is also a Lego room with a large Lego table. There is a section with table toys and a relaxation corner with a carpet, chairs, and about twenty reading books. Another section includes dinosaurs, dolls, ponies, and other figurines such as Walt Disney characters. -Children are supervised at all times when using the washrooms. -Meals are served during recognized mealtimes. -Food brought from home is labeled with the child's name and refrigerated when necessary. -Drinking water is served and available at the time of the inspection. <p>During the monitoring inspection, the quality-assurance mentor observed free play, guided games (Phone, Who is Missing, I Can See in the Dark, 4 Corners), handwashing, and lunch.</p>
