General Comments

- Visit completed at the facility in the afternoon for a monitoring inspection.
- During the visit, the ratio was respected.
- Positive child guidance was witnessed in all rooms during the visit. The educators are at the child's level, discussing with them, engaged in their play, providing support and having conversations. When a conflict arrives between two children, the educators discuss and guide the children on how to reflect their feelings and use words when angry, frustrated or sad.
- Daily incident reports are maintained in the child's file and signed by the parent or guardian.
- In the outdoor play space, the children have more than one type of surfacing to play and explore, the material offered is varied and in sufficient quantity for children present.
- Each child has an easily accessible space to store their personal belongings, which is identified with their name and used only for the intended child. Pacifiers do not have a neck string.

Observations:

Infant room: The children woke up from a nap, participated in free play activities, washed their hands, ate their snack and went outside. Diaper changing was witnessed. The children bring their snack from home. During free play activities, the educators were sitting on the floor with the children talking to them, reading stories and construction with blocks. Parent arrival was witnessed.

2-year-old room: The children ate their snack and went outside to play. The educator was discussing with the children at the table during snack time at their level.

3-year-old room: The children had their snack, participated in free play activities and went outside to play. During free play the children were constructing with the blocks, playing with the cars and creating in the play kitchen.

- 4-5-year-old room: The children had their snack and went outside to play. Parent arrival was witnessed. All snacks and lunches are provided by the parent or guardian.
- Review and discussion with the director on incident report forms Appendix 15. It was discussed with the director what incident is considered reportable. If there is a flood, fire, motor vehicle accident, outbreak, unexpected facility closure and other serious incidents.
