<p>General Comments</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Visit was completed at the facility in the morning for a monitoring inspection. - During the visit ratio was respected. Infants are not mixed with preschool-aged children, except before 8:30 a.m. and after 4:30 p.m. - The daily routine at the establishment includes outdoor playtime at least once every four hours when weather permits. Meals and snacks are served at recognized times, and a daily rest period is provided to meet the children's needs. Lunch and snacks are provided during recognized meal periods. The daily rest period is adapted to meet individual needs. When weather permits, outdoor play occurs twice during a regular day. - Outdoor materials are varied and available in sufficient quantity for all children present - The outdoor play area is maintained in safe conditions. - A first aid kit and a phone are always accessible on site and during outings. - Hot beverages are kept in spill proof containers. Hot beverage containers are kept out of reach of infants and children two years of age and younger. - Medication used for anaphylactic shock (EpiPen) is easily accessible to staff but stored safely and out of children's reach. - Prescribed medication is labelled with the doctor's name, instructions, and the time period for use. - Non prescribed medication is kept in the original child safe container with the original label and is labelled with the child's name and dosage. - All medications are locked and inaccessible to children, and records of administration are maintained. - Observations: Upon my arrival, the children were playing outside. <p>Infant room: During the visit, diaper changing routines were observed, along with proper handwashing and free play activities. The educators were seated on the floor, interacting with the children and speaking gently to them</p> <p>2-year-old room: During free play, the children were building with blocks, playing with cars, and participating in dancing and singing activities.</p> <p>3-year-old room: During free play, the children were creating with playdough and playing with cars.</p> <p>4-5-year-old room:</p>
