clean and well-maintained. Children were observed arriving with their educator in an orderly and supervised manner from the school. Upon entering the facility, they followed hygiene protocols, including handwashing. The younger group entered the indoor space and time for an afternoon snack if they chose. The older group remained outdoors following a washroom break, engaging in physical play in the designated blocked-off parking area and adjacent wooded trails. Supervision was consistent and appropriate for both indoor and outdoor activities.

All new staff files were reviewed and found to be complete, including required documentation and onboarding records. Records of recent fire drills were observed and confirmed to be up to date and compliant with safety regulations. Attendance records were accurately maintained and reflected the children present during the inspection.

Educators were actively engaged with the children throughout the inspection period. Interactions were positive, supportive, and developmentally appropriate. Staff demonstrated awareness of individual needs and maintained a safe and inclusive environment.
