General Comments

A monitoring inspection was conducted today October.9/2025. Upon arrival, educators were engaged in a pre-program briefing, preparing for the children's arrival from school. The environment was organized, and demonstrated readiness to support a smooth transition into the afterschool program.

Educators had prepared various environments and play areas prior to the children's arrival. A space/science station was set up with magnifying glasses, a solar system model, and related materials. Sensory bottles were arranged and accessible to support sensory engagement. The reading area included comfy chairs, a soft rug, and a wide selection of age-appropriate books to foster literacy and quiet time. Art materials were stored in clearly labeled bins, promoting independence and responsibility in material use and care. All areas were visibly clean and well-maintained.

Children were observed arriving with their educator in an orderly and supervised manner from the school. Upon entering the facility, they followed hygiene protocols, including handwashing. The younger group entered the indoor space and time for an afternoon snack if they chose. The older group remained outdoors following a washroom break, engaging in physical play in the designated blocked-off parking area and adjacent wooded trails. Supervision was consistent and appropriate for both indoor and outdoor activities.

All new staff files were reviewed and found to be complete, including required documentation and onboarding records. Records of recent fire drills were observed and confirmed to be up to date and compliant with safety regulations. Attendance records were accurately maintained and reflected the children present during the inspection.

Educators were actively engaged with the children throughout the inspection period. Interactions were positive, supportive, and developmentally appropriate. Staff demonstrated awareness of individual needs and maintained a safe and inclusive environment.
