General Comments
Monitoring Inspection:  Children and educators observed engaged in a variety of activities this afternoon including dramatic play, creating tin foil sculptures, sensory opportunities, air hockey, foosball, and exploring animal lifecycles in the science area. A small group of children built an obstacle course with foam blocks. Children were observed working together and taking turns as they created the course together.  Each group participated in outdoor play this afternoon; one group went on a neighbourhood walk and the other explored the snow in the outdoor play area.  Purposeful planning is evident through documentation and invitations set-up for the children when they arrive to the afterschool program. Photos of the children, learning stories, ongoing projects and art pieces are displayed throughout the learning environment. Documentation includes connection to the NB Curriculum Framework.  During inspection QA Monitor asked staff in Group 1 how many children were present, the number given did not match the number of children signed in on the attendance. The staff immediately gathered all children together and took attendance. Ensure frequent headcounts are conducted, attendance is accurate and all staff are aware of the number of children present at all times.  During transitions to outdoor play, it was observed that some children were required to wait for long periods of time. QA Monitor recommends taking children out in small groups. Example: when 15 children are dressed and ready, one staff takes them out and the other staff stays back with the children who require more time.  Handwashing routines were observed after outdoor play and before snack. Child-to-staff ratio was observed to be met during Monitoring Inspection. New staff file (2) review was completed, all required documents are in place.
