<p>General Comments</p> <p>Monitoring Inspection:</p> <p>Children and educators observed engaged in a variety of activities this afternoon including outdoor play, art, dramatic play, and games. A group of children were observed playing store with their educator; they were shopping and the educator scanned their items and collected the money. A few children were engaging in play at the air hockey table. All children spent time outdoor this afternoon. The children explored the wooded area and relaxed in hammocks. The wooded area is well defined by marked boundaries and educators situate themselves throughout to ensure adequate supervision.</p> <p>Purposeful planning is evident through documentation, invitations and materials added to the environment to support the children's current interests (worms, ducks, puzzles, hockey and soccer). Photos of the children and their learning experiences are displayed throughout the environment. The children have built a worm farm, have been collecting worms and learning about their importance to the environment. The group is also incubating duck eggs and learning about how to care for ducklings.</p> <p>During inspection one educator was not aware of how many children were in their group when asked. Ensure that educators know how many children are present at all times.</p> <p>In response to previous recommendations regarding transition times, the QA Monitor observed that children were not experiencing extended periods of waiting. Educators supported transitions by bringing smaller groups to the outdoor play area rather than having the full group wait for all the children to be ready.</p> <p>Handwashing routines were observed at arrival, after outdoor play and before snack. Monthly fire drills are documented. Daily attendance records are accurate and reflect all children present. Child-to-staff ratio was observed to be met during Monitoring Inspection. New staff file (2) review was completed; all required documents are in place.</p>
