<p>Each room is exploring topics of interest based on identified interests of the children. A variety of styles of documentation are visible throughout the children's learning environment that include: webs, songs, learning stories, word walls, art creations, photos, and so on. The children's portfolios have current entries and they are stored accessible to the children for them to take joy in. The interest centers have a variety of props and materials available to the children and stored in an inviting manner on low, open shelving.</p> <p>The children were observed to be engaged in play while circulating through the interest centers. Circle time activities included singing, engaging with books, and contributing recent memories to the group. The 3's and 4's rooms enjoyed outdoor play in the morning and afternoon. Educators participated along with the children at their level and interactions were positive and respectful.</p>
