General Comments
<p>Renewal Inspection:</p> <p>Lady Bugs: The infants were observed during snack time. When they finished eating, educators assisted them in getting ready to go outside. Upon returning indoors, the educators helped the children get undressed and wash up for lunch. The educators shared that the infants are currently interested in snow. Learning stories, photos, and the infants' artwork supported this.</p> <p>Chickadees: The children were observed playing with magnetic blocks, pop-its, the light pad, and decorating brown paper bags for Valentine's Day. New toys had been introduced to the children, and the educators documented the children's play experiences and learning with these new materials.</p> <p>Kangaroos: The children were observed playing with busy boards, cars and trucks, fishing games, magnetic blocks, and puzzles. The documentation was current and reflected the children's ongoing learning.</p> <p>Monkey Tails: The children were observed playing with magnetic blocks, cars and trucks, and the sensory bin. A group art activity was set out on the table, including a large piece of paper, cookie cutters, glue, petals, stickers, markers, crayons, and other materials. The educators shared that the children are currently learning about snow and are beginning to transition into learning about Arctic animals.</p> <p>Fireflies: The children were observed playing with cars and trucks, Valentine's games, painting, busy boards, decorating brown paper bags for Valentine's Day, and making music with instruments. The educator shared that the children have been learning about kindness.</p>

General Comments

All classrooms were observed going outside. During outdoor play, the children were observed sliding and playing in the snow. The educators were observed sliding with the children and engaging in positive interactions while playing in the snow alongside them.

The following records were reviewed: Incident logs, fire drills, educator professional learning hours, infant toddler daily sheets, and daily attendance sheets.

All staff files were viewed, and a random review of the children's files was completed.
