In one classroom, the inspector observed a free craft activity where children were using glue and scissors, as well as the lunch period and rest period.
The inspector did not inspect the vehicles used for children's transportation because they were not at the facility, they were at another location. The Quality Assurance Monitor will inspect the vehicle during her next visit.
A discussion is held with the administrator regarding the employee's files, all files must be completed with no certificates missing from them.
