Comments: During the monitoring inspection the Quality Assurance Monitor noticed that the educators did not have the attendance record sheet outside. The Quality Assurance Monitor asked the educator to go get the attendance sheet record and bring it outside. When the educator brought the attendance sheet outside, the Quality Assurance Monitor noticed that the children had not been signed in on the government's attendance sheet, the educators had only signed the children in on the facilities attendance sheet. The Quality Assurance Monitor told the educators that children must be signed in on the government's attendance sheet. The educators then proceeded to sign in with the children on the government sheet right away. Deficiency is now compliant.			
9(1) The child-to-staff ratio is one educator for each of the following groups of children of the same age receiving services at a full-time or part-time early learning and childcare centre: (a) three infants or fewer; (b) five children or fewer who are two years of age; (c) eight children or fewer who are three years of age; (d) ten children or fewer who are four years of age or older, but who are not yet attending school; and (e) 15 school-age children or fewer.	9(1)	Nov 22, 2023	Nov 22, 2023
Comments: When the Quality Assurance Monitor asked the educators how many children were present, the educators stated that 24 children were present today. The Quality Assurance Monitor counted multiple times and only counted 21 children. When the Quality Assurance Monitor told the educators that the Quality Assurance Monitor was only counting 21 children, the educators said that one child was inside using the bathroom with an inclusion support worker. The Quality Assurance Monitor told the educators that there were still 2 children missing. The educator asked the children to freeze in position and the Quality Assurance Monitor and the educator counted the children together. 22 children were counted plus the child inside, the Quality Assurance Monitor told the educator that one child was still missing, the educator went inside to get the attendance sheet and proceeded to confirm that there were only 23 children present and not 24. The Quality Assurance Monitor had a discussion with the operator and administrator in regards of the situation and reminded the administrator and operator that educator must know how many children are present at all times. Deficiency is now compliant.
