General Comments
<p>Children and Educators engaged in play in the indoor and outdoor environments during today's monitoring inspection. Educators were observed to be engaged in play and conversation along side children. Hand washing was observed before children sat for snack.</p> <p>Documentation posted in rooms 15 and 17 demonstrated children's current interests and learning. Children's print was also displayed throughout. This values children's contributions to their environment and creates a sense of belonging.</p> <p>As discussed, keeping documentation posted as projects and interests change and evolve, provides opportunities for parents and visitors to see the ongoing learning and demonstrates that the requirement for a purposefully planned and documented program is met.</p> <p>For children with extreme or life threatening allergies, it is recommended that the allergy be posted in the room. Also, ensure that the Extreme Allergy Management and Emergency plan is updated with clear directions in case of emergency and signed off yearly. A copy should be kept with the epi-pen and also in the child's file. Recommendation that staff working with children with life threatening allergies review section 10.4 of the operator manual.</p>
