General Comments
A renewal inspection was conducted today. The children were observed during snack, free play, outside play and lunch. Children's learning is displayed in each of the rooms in the form of: webs, art, learning stories, charts, and pictures. The rooms have age appropriate materials for the children to interact and engage with as well as

defined interest centres making it easy for children to transition from one interest to another.

The educators were observed having positive respectful and meaningful conversations with the children. The children were observed appearing happy and content in their respective early learning environments and with their educators.

Recommending that with Spring approaching the educators do a daily check of the outside play area for debris/garbage that may appear after the snow melts and having a garbage bag available with gloves to pick up the garbage to dispose of. Also recommending that the snow blower that is on the front step be removed, it was moved so the blades are not facing outwards but must be stored appropriately.
