General Comments

A renewal inspection occurred today.

In Room 14 the current topic of interests for the children is Fire Safety and Reptiles. Educators have invitations for learning set up inspire the children to explore these. A Tuff Tray is set up with invitations exploring snakes and a box has been used to create a turtle habitat. During story time the children were learning about when and when not to call 911 and practiced "stop, drop, and roll" in case of fire.

In Room 15 the current topic of interests for the children is "breakfast". The educators indicated this arose from the previous interests of a pet centre when they made "dog treats" for their pets. The children then started talking about food. The Tuff Tray is set up with breakfast ideas: Toy bacon, eggs, plates, cooking utensil are available for the children to use their imaginations and explore the endless possibilities. The sensory bin had items for children to make their own "cereal" (not to eat).

Adding items to these two rooms such as dress up clothes to support their interests will enhance the children's learning. Items such as a Firemans clothes/hat, baby dolls (to rescue), old vacuum hoses as fire hoses, flashlights, Safari hat, journals to make notes of their reptile finds, transforming the Tuff tray to a crocodile/alligator swamp, Chef hat, aprons, cookbooks, menus, rolling pins, oven mitts, pans to bake, cookie cutters etc.

In the school-age room the children have access to a wide variety of age-appropriate board games, Lego, books, creative art supplies, dolls. etc. The children were observed very engaged in the various learning centres throughout the room.

Educators in all three rooms were observed having meaningful and respectful conversations and interactions with the children in their care and attending to their needs.
