| arrival of licensing staff. In the outdoor play space children had access to swings, sandbox with toys, a teepee, mud kitchen, playhouse, basketball net and slide. Pea gravel around equipment was sufficient. All children were engaged in several activities while outdoors. Children should have access to their water bottles when in the outdoor play area.  Observed children transition to lunch time from outside play area. Children each went to the washroom and washed their hands, and the operator was observed disinfecting the tables before giving each of the children their lunch from home. Positive behaviour guidance was observed at all times as educator redirected children and helped children with their routine.  Indoor play area materials need to be replenished with open ended materials such as blocks, food, dishes, people, animals to help children engage in more prolonged play and to extend on their learning and interests. More books and writing materials should be available to increase opportunities for literacy in various forms.  Children and staff files were well organized and contained all necessary documentation.
