However, it was page 1 of 2 included in the staff files and the regulations ask for both pages. A discussion occurs with the operator and the operator was able to retrieve the staff member valid first aid certificate. The new copy was added into the staff files. Deficiency is now compliant.

While on site, an educator was staying in front of it to ensure no child's escape. The operator must ensure that the door is fixed in order to keep the outdoor play area enclosed and safe.
