General Comments

- -Ratio was respected during the visit
- -Daily activities into the center shows purposely planned and documented programming that gives children, Time, and space for a free choice of play experiences, indoor and outdoor opportunities for physical activity either individually or in a group. Children have opportunities for various forms of literacy and to express creativity and interests, to explore the arts and sciences and to experience accomplishment and success. They have opportunities to problem solve and to develop trusting, respectful and supportive relationships.
- -Children's guidance is done in a respectful and positive way
- -Posted in a visible and prominent place in the facility are the following documents: The licence, inspection report, orders for compliance, daily routine, evacuation procedures, name of administrator, name and telephone number of QA Monitor and inspector Life threatening allergies and a notice to inform parents of the existence of a communicable disease.
- -Indoor play area is maintained safe and clean
- -Outdoor play occurs for at least one hour in each four-hour block of time when the majority of children receiving services are in attendance weather permitting
- -Rest periods meet individual needs
- -Snacks are provided at least every 3 hours and meals are provided at recognized meal periods
- -The gateway to the fenced outdoor space is well maintained, snow or ice does not prevent the door from closing.

Observations: When arriving at the center infants are into free play, 2 educators were reading a book with a group of children. They all got their diaper changed, washed their hands, and ate lunch. The twos were napping when I got into the room, soft music was playing, and the room was dark and cozy. The threes were finishing lunch, using the washroom, and getting ready for nap time.
