The learning environments are welcoming and each room has a variety of materials for the children to interact and engage with. Educators were eager to show their rooms and discuss what the children were learning and engaging with.

Educators were observed down on the floor with the children having respectful and resposive relationships, conversations with the children and tending to the children's individual needs.

In each of the learning environments the children's learning is displayed in a variety of ways: Webs, learning stores, pictures and art. These are displayed low so that the children can revisit these experiences at any time.
