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General Comments Upon arrival, the QAM visited Room 9. The children were having a snack and participating in their morning song. During the activity, children were invited to give high-fives if they chose to participate. Educators were observed engaging positively with the children and fostering a welcoming learning environment. Educators shared that the children's current interests include sensory experiences, painting, colors, and water play. A wilderness-themed invitation was available on the floor, allowing children easy access and opportunities for participation. Documentation and developmentally appropriate materials were observed throughout the learning environment. In Room 11, children were observed singing action songs while tracing letters. Other children were painting on a large sheet of paper placed on the floor and exploring nature-based invitations. Educators remained actively engaged with the children and provided support and encouragement throughout the activities. During the observation of Rooms 10 and 12 outdoors, children were listening to music and participating in bubble play. Some children were engaged in play with trucks, moving throughout the outdoor environment. Positive child guidance practices were observed when a child became upset. An educator responded promptly by providing comfort and support as the child appeared unsettled by unfamiliar visitors in the environment. Educators reported that the children's current interests include bubbles, water play, vehicles, and animal sounds. All learning environments were observed to be clean, organized, and well maintained. Staff files were reviewed and found to be complete and up to date.
