Children were observed in both inside and outside play during inspection. Hand-washing routine was observed after outside play before snack.

Current documentation showing the children's learning is displayed on the walls in the forms of pictures and captions. Children's art creations are displayed. Educator indicated that a lot of the children's creations go home each day.

Children were observed engaged with a variety of materials in their environments and appeared happy and content. The educator was observed engaged in conversation and learning with the children and speaking respectfully to the children.
