General Comments

Progress has been made in the environments, daily programming and activities. All staff are using a planning tool to document their planning, all rooms have documentation posted and additional art materials, paper & mark making materials are now present. One room has focused on enhancing play with loose-parts, this demonstrates how the educators value the children and their environment by providing more opportunities for exploration, manipulation, and sensory learning. QAM sent additional resources to Director on Emergent Curriculum.

Director advised QAM that children's files have been updated to date for all children whose files have been returned by parents/ guardians.

Operator has added mulch to outdoor play area and staff will continue to loosen protective surfacing as needed. Two additional shade structures have been added.

Facility is waiting for the health inspection and the licence will be in continuation until a recommendation from health has been received; at which time the licence will be renewed.
