Comments: A child's EpiPen is kept in their backpack, which is kept on the child's hook in the classroom. This medication must be inaccessible to the children. This was addressed with the educator, who placed the backpack on the top of the shelf, ensuring that the EpiPen is inaccessible to the children. Deficiency is now compliant

Comments: Inspector observed that the changing mat has some small rips on the sides, making the changing surface no longer covered with a non-absorbent layer. Administrator must ensure that this is replaced.

## **General Comments**

During the renewal inspection, Inspector observed morning snack, indoor play, outdoor play, lunch as well as the rest period. Inspector observed positive interactions between the educators and the children, such as the educators getting on the children's level to interact with them, interactions during diaper changes as well as comforting children when needed. Inspector observed that positive child guidance was practiced by educators, by setting reasonable limits and guidelines that make sense to the children as well as gentle reminders. Documentation of children's learning was made evident through various forms, such as learning stories posted on the wall as well as in the child's induvial portfolio, webs as well as art posted on the walls.

Inspector observed that the infants and the two-year-old groups are mixed together during outdoor play. A discussion was had with the administrator and staff, as infants are not permitted to be grouped with children of another age group. During the inspection, a clear division of the outdoor play area was made, in order to ensure that both groups remain separate. Administrator must also ensure that a second surface is added to the infant's outdoor play area in order to promote a natural outdoor play experiences for children.

Inspector recommends that curtains be placed around the toilets in the infant / two year old bathroom, to allow for more privacy.
