Comments: During the renewal inspection, the inspector observed 3 children, each 2years old, along with 3 infants, in the bathroom during diaper change and toilet use. The inspector discussed the regulations with the educators and the educator responsible for the group of 2 years old immediately returned to her classroom and came back to the bathroom when it was available. Deficiency is now compliant			
31(3) An operator shall maintain the outdoor play area of a licensed facility to ensure the safety of the children.	31(3)	Jul 05, 2024	
Comments: During the renewal inspection, the inspector observed a wood log covering a part of the fence that is loose, to ensure no child could escape. While on site, educators were staying close to the fence. The operator must ensure that the wires and part of the loose fence is fixed in order to keep the outdoor play area enclosed and safe. The administrator stated that the maintenance guy was already scheduled to come fix the fence today.

Comments: The inspector observed a Bottle of liquid Benadryl in a locked cabinet supplied by the facility. However, only acetaminophen can be supplied by the operator. During the inspection, the administrator took the medication out of the facility. Deficiency is now compliant			

General Comments

During the renewal inspection, inspector observed indoor play, outdoor play, lunch as well as the rest period. Inspector observed positive interactions between the educators and the children, such as the educators getting on the children's level to interact with them. Soft music is playing during nap time. Inspector observed documentation of children's learnings by the learning stories, art and webbing posted on the walls in the classroom.

The inspector observed that completed paperwork are in the entrance of the facility and emergency contacts are posted inside the facility. To ensure that documentations regarding children are kept confidential, the inspector recommends changing the location of the document.

General Comments

An application for change must be submitted for a new administrator. Changes will have to be made to the parent handbook. A new copy must be sent to the inspector and given to parents.
