Comments: In 1 of the 10 child record files verified the address of the emergency contacts are incomplete. The city part of the addresses is missing. The child's record file must include name, address and telephone number of at least 2 emergency contact. The operator must make sure that all child records are complete.			

General Comments
<p>The Quality Assurance Monitor is on site for a monitoring inspection. The ratio was respected at the time of the visit.</p> <p>The following elements were verified:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -The outdoor play area -The outdoor play area materials -Diaper changing -Child records files <p>The Quality Assurance Monitor had a discussion with the administrator regarding consents who were left blank in some of the child files verified. All consents, including the consent for school transportation must be filed out even if the child in question does not attend school at the moment. The QAM also observed in the outdoor play area that there was a lack of toys for the children to play with. Although the children didn't seem to be bored, the QAM suggest to the administrator that more toys should be added so the children can have more types of play.</p> <p>At the time of the visit, the QAM observed a class finishing eating their snack. QAM also observed children listening to music and dancing. The QAM observed the children transitioning to the outdoor play area.</p> <p>During the monitoring inspection, the QAM added new staff in the system.</p>
