Comments: A large shelf was installed in this room, the length of one wall. QA monitor verified that although it reduces the measured play space, there is still enough room for the number of children on the license. Any changes impacting play space must first be communicated to QA Monitor.

Comments: A metal bar is imbedded in the ground of the play ground. There is no longer a climber installed on this bar and, being exposed, it causes a hazard and must be removed immediately. The storage box in the play ground is broken, no lid and has sharp edges – it must be disposed of immediately. Inadequate storage for toys – many toys strewn around the yard and the buckets are filled with rain water and must be dumped out. Standing water was observed in the play ground, and in the tires. Water must not be permitted to accumulate – adequate drainage on the ground and in the tires is required.
