Comments: Basement stairs and carpet are dirty, must be swept, vacuumed and mopped. Accumulation of dirt on floors behind doors and in corners. Must be swept and mopped. QA Monitor recommends that the Operator review cleaning schedule with all staff and ensure that staff understand their responsibilities with regard to cleanliness of facility.
