Comments: Several of the audited files have either incomplete contact information or a contact who is further than one hour away. Emergency contact information must be complete (phone number, civic number, street and city) and must be able to pick up the child within one hour.			
31(3) An operator shall maintain the outdoor play area of a licensed facility to ensure the safety of the children.	31(3)	Aug 27, 2020	
Comments: Standing water in the mud kitchen sinks poses a health hazard and must be removed, sinks cleaned & disinfected. Broken traffic cone has jagged edges and must be disposed of.			
33(2) Stationary equipment in the outdoor play area shall be surrounded by a protective surfacing and installed according to the manufacturer's instructions.	33(2)	Sep 02, 2020	
Comments: Ground has compacted and protective surfacing is an inadequate depth around / under some of the equipment.			
40(1) An operator of a licensed facility shall ensure that personal belongings of a child receiving services at the licensed facility that are brought to the licensed facility, including combs, brushes, toothbrushes, towels, washcloths, bedding, pacifiers and soothers, are (a) labelled with the name of the child.	40(1)(a)	Aug 28, 2020	
Comments: Some of the children's cubbies are not labelled with the name of the child. All in-use cubbies must be labelled with the name of the child using the cubby.			
44 An operator of a licensed facility shall have a first aid kit that is equipped with the contents prescribed by New Brunswick Regulation 2004-130 under the Occupational Health and Safety Act as a first aid kit that is not a personal, Type P first aid kit, and a telephone in working order (a) on the premises of the licensed facility.	44(a)	Aug 26, 2020	Aug 26, 2020
Comments: First aid kit must be complete, the audited kit was missing some gauze pads. Were replaced during the inspection. Deficiency is now compliant
