Comments:	Comments: Inspector observed some of the wires of the black fencing are coming apart and will need to be resecured to the fence in order to ensure that the outdoor play area is maintained safe and free of hazard.						
General Comments							

During the renewal inspection, inspector observed the children arrive from school and indoor play. Inspector observed free play, some children were making clothes out of fabric while others were playing sports. Inspector observed positive interactions between the educators and the children, such as setting reasonable boundaries and rules that make sense to the children. Inspector observed that the classrooms are set up based on the children's interest, such as a horse stable corner.

Inspector observed that the children's allergy information was posted in the eating area of the classroom. A discussion was had with the administrator regarding ensuring that the children's allergy information is posted in the food preparation area. The information was moved above the microwave immediately by the administrator.

A discussion was had with the Administrator regarding a large puddle of water that accumulates in the outdoor play area after rain. Administrator indicates that they are looking at possible solutions to ensure that this drains properly.

Administrator must ensure that the inspector's name and contact information is updated within the facility.
