| Comments: The Quality Assurance Monitor observed 2 bookbags, 3 jackets, 1 shirt, 3 pairs of boots and 4 water bottles on the floor in front of the designated personal storage space. The children are provided a space to store their personal items separately. However, at the time the Quality Assurance Monitor could not identify who's belonging belonged to who. When the Quality Assurance Monitor notified the educator, they proceeded to identify a selection and was unsure about certain items and asked the children. Keeping items separate avoids the risk of losing or mixing up personal belongings and also reduces the risk of spreading communicable diseases.
