Comments: In 1 of the 8 child profiles verified, the consent for transporting the child or providing transportation for school- aged children was filled out as non-applicable. The child is attending school and receiving transportation from school to the childcare center with their minivan. The administrator called the parent to obtain verbal consent to change the signed consent for school transportation. The Quality Assurance Monitor informed the administrator that the parent must initial the consent form in the child's profile when picking up their child from the center. Deficiency is now compliant

Comments: While conducting the renewal inspection, the Quality Assurance Monitor observed in the classroom downstairs an electric baseboard that was broken. The cover was taken off, making the sharp edges inside a potential danger for the children. The baseboard was removed from the indoor play area and will be replaced at a later time. Deficiency is now compliant

Comments: While verifying the outdoor play area, the Quality Assurance Monitor observed that the entrance door to the playground could not be closed properly. A bungee cord was used to keep the door shut, leaving a gap between the door and the fence. This is a potential danger for children as it doesn't close properly. The outdoor play area must be maintained safe and free of hazards. The Quality Assurance Monitor was informed that a fencing company has already been contacted to fix the fence in the upcoming weeks.

Comments: The Quality Assurance Monitor observed 4 bottles of water not labeled with the name of the child. Personal belongings must be labelled with the name of the child. The names were added to the bottles. Deficiency is now compliant							

General Comments

The Quality Assurance Monitor is on site to conduct the renewal inspection. The ratio was respected during the inspection.

When the QAM arrived on site, the children were finishing eating their morning snack and getting ready to go to the bottle and can redemption center to return the bottles and cans they collected during their annual fundraiser. The money collected will go towards buying materials, toys, or going on outings during the summer. The QAM observed the children eating their lunch, playing in the indoor play area, and playing with water outside to cool down. A group of children were also observed singing songs with a child playing the guitar.
