General Comments

I, inspector Kelsey Colford, accompanied by quality assurance monitor, Megan Munden, completed the regional inspection of the license. When we arrived, the children were having snack and getting prepared to go play at a nearby park. The space was organized and clean and staff were engaged in conversations with the children throughout the snack. Some children arrived for the day during the snack and staff kept attendance records accurate and up-to-date.

They took the centre's bus to the nearby playground and came prepared for potential rain. All children brought their own water bottles to the playground and were prompted by staff to remove layers or take water breaks throughout. Staff were actively engaged in a wide variety of activities with the children at the playground and there was room for children to choose and switch between individual and smaller group play, on swings and jungle gyms, as well as larger group activities like soccer and basketball. The playground was free of hazards and staff positioned themselves well in the space to keep eyes on the children at all times. The staff engaged with the children on their level and the children were receptive to guidance, direction, and instructions. Their transition to and from the playground went smoothly; staff brought all required materials with them to playground including a first aid kit and emergency contact information.

We returned and observed the children and staff sitting together and eating lunch together before their afternoon activities. There were ample materials observed indoors to offer the children a range of activities including toys, balls, scooters, books, cards, and art supplies.

Files and postings in the centre were well-organized and up to date. A call will be made by the inspector to request a fire inspection; I recommend renewal of the license pending fire inspection.
